

Log and Timber Frame Pricing Information

Our standard pricing information is based on historical pricing data across Canada and the U.S. The variation in price is primarily due to design complexity, local labor costs, and the finishes and amenities chosen by each client.

Packages

- 1. Our log or timber frame packages typically fall between \$25 and \$75 per square foot. Prices vary depending on the style of home you are building:
 - Summit Mountain Retreat
 - Handcrafted Log: Post and Beam/Fusion or Full-Scribe
 - Timber/Timber Frame
- 2. We also have options for "dry-in materials" packages, which include the log or timber frame work as mentioned, along with:
 - SIP Panels for the exterior walls and roof
 - Cedar wavy board siding
 - Windows and exterior doors
 - Stain

These materials packages tend to fall between \$100 and \$150 per square foot.

The two packages described above include a technical representative from Summit Log & Timber Homes, Inc. who works alongside your General Contractor to oversee the installation of your log or timber frame components. *Both packages exclude: shipping, excavation, foundation preparation, and installation labor for the above-mentioned materials.*

Average Turnkey Costs

The typical turnkey price range for a log or timber/timber frame home is \$200 – \$300 per square foot—based on the total heated, finished, livable space constructed out of log or timber frame. The turnkey estimate covers every aspect of the home—from building the foundation to moving in—including finishes, log or timber/timber frame work, and services such as electricity, plumbing, etc.

The estimate excludes only the cost of the land and site preparation work. The pricing on all options varies depending on the site location, finishes chosen, and the size and complexity of the home's design.

Below is a simple chart to help calculate the average turnkey costs for the different home styles we offer.

When calculating, be certain to include the square footage for both the main and second floors (where applicable). In addition to the above, you may want to build the items listed in the below chart.

However, the typical turnkey price range for a high-end resort area such as: Jackson, Wyoming; Park City, Utah; Sun Valley, Idaho; Aspen, Colorado, etc., is estimated to be between \$500 – \$800 per square foot and up.
